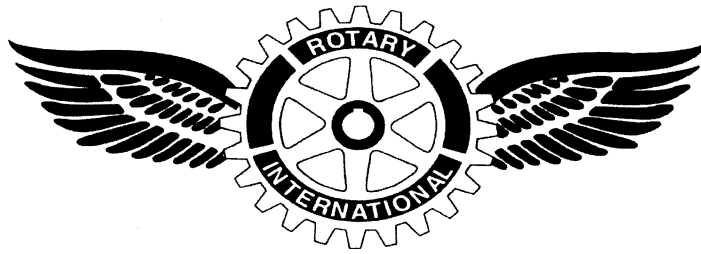

IFFR Fly-in to Mount Gambier South Australia October 10th – 12th, 2008

We have organised a pleasant Fly-in for October and hope that you will join us there. In October the mean temperature is 18° (range 9 – 33). S.A.'s time zone is GMT + 9 ½ hours.

Mount Gambier Airport: is a security controlled airport; landing fees apply. We shall make arrangements to simplify/expedite arrivals and departures. ASIC's will be required to be worn by one member of each aircraft (usually the pilot). We will be welcomed by members of the Mount Gambier Aero Club including a complementary cuppa. As the airport is 5 nm north of the city we have arranged a shuttle bus to be available from 1400 to 1700.

Accommodation: It is recommended that those *without* cars book in to The Lakes Resort (details below). When booking quote IFFR and you will receive a 10% discount provided that you book before 9th September. Although all could stay there, two alternative venues are listed below but will require your own transport.

Friday evening dinner (optional): (1830 – 1900 start) The Lakes Resort has an excellent restaurant and it is recommended that we gather there for dinner. We have pre-ordered a 2 course menu with 1 choice of soup or entrée and 3 choices of main for \$36. We will need numbers at least 1 week prior.

Saturday Tour: (0900 from The Lakes Resort, picking up at other motels if necessary on the way.) An interesting day tour has been planned and will include a visit to the volcanic lakes of Mount Gambier followed by a short coach trip north to Penola. This quaint village has much to offer so you will be let loose to browse for an hour or so and to buy your morning tea. We will then travel a short distance north into the Coonawarra Wine District visiting wineries before and after lunch. Lunch will be at The Kitchen, a fairly new restaurant which is offering a choice of 4 main meals followed by tea/coffee. Other drinks will be at your expense.

We will depart Coonawarra in time to reach a lovely old homestead, Yallum Park not far from Penola by 1500. It is expected that, his health permitting, the 90 year old owner, Mr. Clifford, will show us around. Following this we will drive back to Mount Gambier around 1630 in time for you to rest and 'clean up' before dinner.

Saturday Dinner: (1830 for 1900) We will be guests at the Rotary Club of Mount Gambier's 80th birthday celebrations at The Lakes Resort. Dress for the men will be lounge suit.

Sunday meeting: Will be held at The Lakes Resort and will include morning tea. A coach will then take those without cars to the airport where the Mount Gambier Aero Club will host our lunch.

After lunch we say farewell to those departing that afternoon.
